

STARTING SIGNALS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

Crews should line up between the two large marker buoys ready to be called forward to the start line by the Starter.

The signal for assembly will be the raising of the RED FLAG whereby crews come under Starters orders.

When the starter is ready he shall lower the red flag and replace it by raising a YELLOW flag and the race shall be started by the dropping of the YELLOW flag which may be accompanied by a verbal "Go" the "Go" to coincide with the dropping of the flag which is the overriding signal.

Note that it is the responsibility of the stroke oarsmen to get their boats into position as quickly as possible without any help from the starter, and it should be unnecessary for any boat to be rowed across the line before the starting signal.

It is emphasised that the order to start racing is the dropping of the YELLOW FLAG and that the verbal command may or may not be audible to all crews on the water.

COURSE

From a well defined transit starting line in the sea off the old pier apron, row 800 metres North East and turn buoys, row back through the starting line to finish. Any crew which is beyond the next groyne southwards of the line when their race is called to the start may be assumed by the officials to be not entering the race. The Committee may decide to shorten the course if circumstances dictate.

RULES

Hants and Dorset ARA rules for regattas and boat racing shall be observed. Crews must start and finish between the outer limit buoy and the seaward starting post. Boat numbers must be displayed on the fore end. Practising on the course during the regatta may lead to disqualification.

SAFETY and COMMUNICATIONS

Safety advisor is James Thompson, 23 Daniel Street, Ryde 07795 977815, and the water safety and communications plan has been issued to all competing clubs and Racing Officials and is also in the programme.

It is expected that all competing clubs boats will meet the safety standards laid down by the British Rowing Water Safety Code of Practice.

Telephones in emergency

Telephones are available at Regatta Control . (Old Pier Stub)

In addition the various hotels and shops along the seafront will have phones.

Launch Rescue Kits.

Will be in the Umpires boat, the Sandown Shanklin Inshore Rescue Boat the Shanklin RC and the Shanklin Sailing Club launch. The minimum equipment in each kit being loud hailer, sound signalling device, first aid kit, knife, rope, exposure blankets, throw line and lifejacket.

Rescue Boats

The main rescue service afloat will be provided by Sandown Shanklin Inshore Rescue who will have a fully equipped craft afloat with a qualified crew. In addition the Shanklin RC , Shanklin Sailing Club and Wight Water ribs will be in attendance. There is always the possibility that the Inshore Rescue could be called away for an emergency at short notice.

Radio communications

The Inshore Rescue craft will be in contact with their HQ and Regatta Control who will be in contact with the Umpires and other rescue craft.

The PA system will cover the area of the Start/Regatta Control, the boat park and launching area and generally around the Shanklin RC Clubhouse.

First Aid Cover

Will be provided by Michelle Vidovic (07912 964635) at Regatta control adjacent to the starters. First Aid kits are also located at the boathouse, Regatta Control and in the umpires and safety boats. H&D mobile defibrillator located with First Aider at Regatta Control. Also defibrillator in box on the wall of the SSRC clubhouse by the steps.

It is safe to bring boats ashore along most of the length of the course the exception being the area marked on the course map.



SHANKLIN ACCIDENT & EMERGENCY PLAN

1 CREWS

If you sink or capsize, do not try to swim ashore. Stay with the boat and wait for the safety launch to come to you. An upturned boat is easier to spot in the water than a person's head.

If you are near the shore, you can try to move the boat onto the beach but do not let go of the boat. Keep a firm hold with one hand.

2 SAFETY BOAT CREWS

When attending an incident make sure that all crew members are out of the boat, especially in a capsize. Remember a coastal four has a crew of five, **and also be aware of the danger of a rotating propeller.**

Radio to control that all is well, or otherwise, and having picked up the crew bring them back to the shore as near as possible to Regatta Control and the First Aid post.

In the event of injury, leave the boat to be towed by someone else and get the casualty back to the shore and First Aid as quickly as possible.

3 REGATTA CONTROL.

If you are informed by the Safety crews or Umpire that a potentially serious situation is developing, immediately inform the First Aid personnel. Try to ascertain on their behalf any relevant information, abrasions, fractures, resuscitation required etc.

If the situation is serious do not hesitate to call the emergency services.

4 SAFETY ADVISOR

Ensure that the safety log and reports are satisfactorily filled out.
